NATURE OF THE FUNCTION:

Under the authority of the Telephony Team Leader in the IT department, the incumbent is a person who analyzes the technical needs of the users, designs the appropriate systems, and ensures their development and implementation. She/he prepares cost analyses and estimates the savings to be generated by the proposed system. She/he coordinates the implementation of new technology and software applications. She/he ensures the optimal use of computer systems. She/he ensures the proper monitoring of the systems and their surroundings. Specifically in regards to responsibilities related to access management.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Works on group projects throughout all phases: inception, planning, implementation and follow-up.
- Makes recommendations and participates in technological decision making.
- Is responsible for specific systems ensuring their proper operational maintenance and evolution as well as providing their support at 2nd and 3rd level.
- Works with different types of technologies including: wireless networks, IP and traditional telephony (Avaya), Cisco switching, network monitoring tools etc.
- Creates and maintains documentation of their important tasks and the various technologies they are responsible for (i.e. inventory, history etc.).
- Writes tenders to proceed to major equipment acquisitions.
- Assures and maintains patient safety, privacy and confidentiality.
- Works in accordance with the norms of the Ministère de Service Santé et Sociaux.
